


Housing Resources

The Massachusetts Section 8 Centralized Waiting List is a partnership of 101 Public Housing Authorities within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts which streamlines their application process for Section 8 Voucher. https://www.gosection8.com/MASSCWL

Residential Assistance for Families in Transition (RAFT) & Emergency Rent and Mortgage Assistance (ERMA)

The state-funded RAFT and ERMA programs provide eligible households up to \$4,000 per 12-month period that can be used to help retain their housing, obtain new housing, or otherwise avoid becoming homeless. For COVID-related housing crises, the maximum RAFT benefit has increased from \$4,000 to \$10,000 per household, on the condition that the landlord agrees to preserve the tenancy for 6 months, or until June 2021 for households with schoolaged children, whichever is longer.
